2. Applicants are to be graduating 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders, generally from the 3 parishes of St. Anastasia, St. Jerome and Visitation. Children and grandchildren of Council #3744 members are also eligible, regardless of their parish.
3. Applicants are to be practicing Catholics.

The Knights of Columbus are dedicated to the principles of **Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. Family and Faith** are foundational pillars of the Knights. Letters of recommendations that reflect these precepts in regards to the applicant are highly recommended. Other important considerations include the applicant's **academics, character, citizenship and leadership.**
