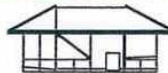

Throughout March, the Council will be hosting four fish frys. Sharing a Lenten Friday dinner brings us together in prayer, in community and in breaking bread. Purchasing dinner at the fish fry not only helps meet your Lenten obligation, it enables the Council to continue funding our Scholarship Program. Please make attending the fish frys part of your Lenten routine.

As mentioned last month, the Council officers are putting together a survey that all members are encouraged to reply to. We are anxious to hear your views of the Council, and any suggestions you have to help move our Council forward.

I hope to see you at the Hall in March!

4 Every Girl

Female sexualization is of increasing concern in today's media. More and more, women - and even young girls - are portrayed as sex objects, are told that their physical appearance is the only thing about them that matters, and are even urged by the entertainment and beauty industries to act out sexually. The result is an increase of mental health problems - eating disorders, depression and low self-esteem. Our girls deserve better. This is why the Parents Television Council (PTC) has launched its 4 Every Girl initiative.

By creating a safe place for girls, 4 Every Girl brings increased awareness and concern to the work of other organizations in the fight for healthier media images of young girls. The PTC committed its capabilities in the areas of media research, public education, public policy and grassroots advocacy in an effort to achieve positive change. A public service announcement (aired on five networks) increased public awareness and concern for protecting girls from sexualization.
