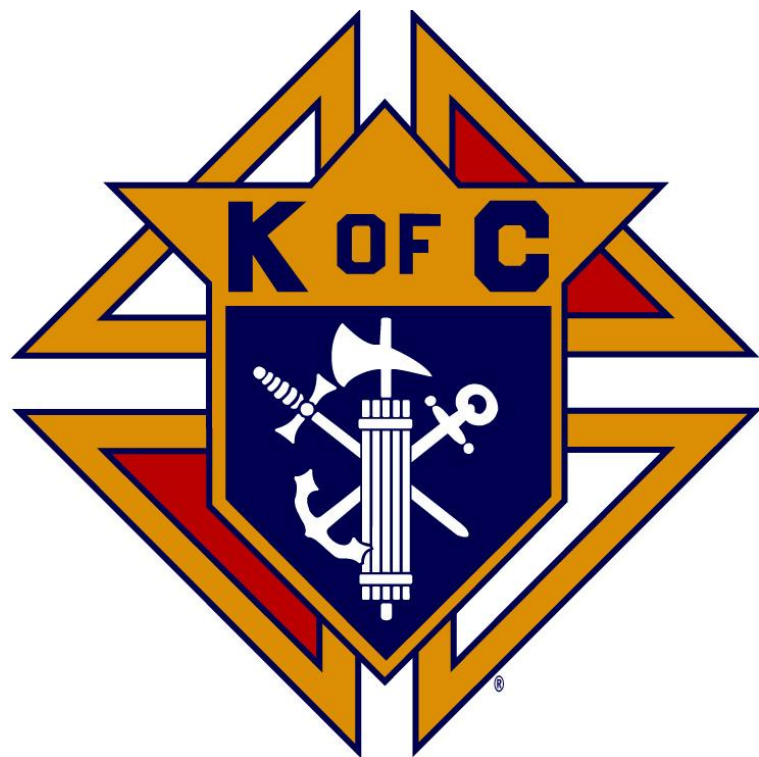

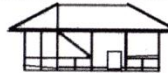

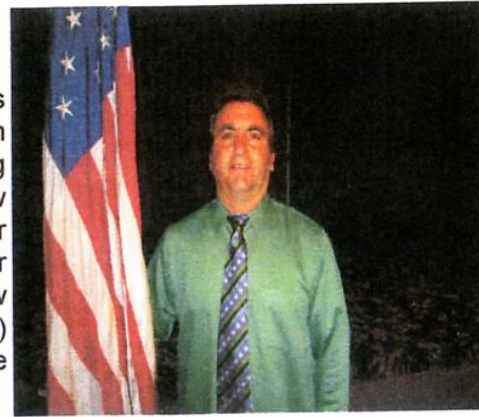

Pro-Life Report

Controlling the Countries

A presentation given in Ethiopia: On December 10, 1974, the U.S. National Security Council presented a top-secret report entitled NSSM-200, also called the Kissinger Report. Since then declassified, it detailed a strategy by which the United States would aggressively promote population control in developing countries in order to regulate (and have access to) the natural resources of these countries. The 13 countries named were: Ethiopia, India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nigeria, Mexico, Indonesia, Brazil, the Philippines, Thailand, Egypt, Turkey and Columbia.

According to NSSM-200, elements of the population control programs could include the legalization of abortion, sterilization and contraception, indoctrination of children, mandatory population control, and withholding of disaster and food relief. The policies of this document are eminently relevant today. Governments of wealthy nations and multi-billion dollar foundations fund the development industry. The language used is now "pro-woman" instead of "population control."

It is truly shocking how blatant are the efforts of those who promote the Culture of Death against nations who stubbornly cling to the common sense idea that children are good, and that they are the future.

“Remembering a Brother Knight”

Sir Knight, Robert J. Young – Past Grand Knight, passed away on Sunday evening, May 12, 2013. In December this year, Bob would have turned 79 years of age. He was born in Elmira, New York and would later settle in Westchester, California. In the year 1988, Bob led Council 3744 as its Grand Knight, but he was certainly better known as the trusted Treasurer of the Council, a post he held for over 18 years. Bob insisted the Council always maintain a safety cushion each year in the treasury and kept that promise year after year. At budget meetings usually held in July of each year, Bob would remind the officers of our most important principal – charity. He would steer the Council on the correct path towards charitable work and his final vote was to make the annual donation to Kapaun Mt. Carmel Catholic High School in Wichita, Kansas. Bob was a 28 year Life Member of the Council and in those years served as the Council Lecturer, Chancellor, Deputy Grand Knight, Grand Knight and was a Sir Knight of the 4th Degree Fr. Hawe Assembly. A notable program that Bob developed and served as chairman for 15 years was the Annual Council Picnic. He led the set-up team for the Fish Fry Dinner seasons for many years before handing off to Vince Migliazzo PGK. As a true friend – Bob would pick up Brother Knight Fred Dyke (now deceased), who was restricted to a wheel chair and bring him to meetings and Fish Fry's. On the way home, he would drop off dinners to Bill and Mary Drenick (now both deceased). Bob volunteered at the St. Joseph Center (for 25 years), helped produce the Council Bulletin and received both Family of the Year and Knight of the Year awards. Bob was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, graduated from UCLA and for 37 years was an analyst with the Rand Corporation. From Council meetings, Degrees, special events to Fish Fry's, Bob was always present, helpful and a true leader. We will truly miss our Brother Bob Young! We wish our sincere condolences to Bob's wife, Betty and their two children. We will *never* forget our brother, **Past Grand Knight and Sir Knight of Council 3744 – Bob Young**.
