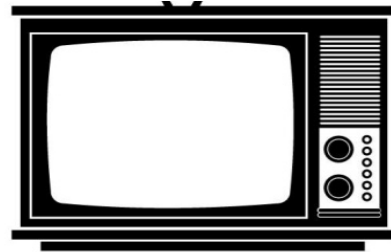

The basic rating denotes the audience that the show is aimed toward.

TV Y7 FV	Directed to Older Children-Fantasy Violence
TV G	General Audience
TV PG	Parental Guidance Suggested
TV 14	Parents Strongly Cautioned
TV MA	Mature Audience Only

One or more letters may be added to the basic rating to indicate that a show contains higher levels of violence, sex, adult language or suggestive dialogue:

V	Violence
S	Sexual situations
L	Coarse or crude indecent language
D	Suggestive dialogue (usually means talk about sex)
FV	Fantasy violence
