

Decency Report

NO DIVORCE!!!

There is a city in this world in which family bonds are so strong that there is no record of divorce. This privileged city is Siroki-Brijeg. Located in Bosnia, its approximately 26,000 inhabitants of Croatian origin, have always been ready to defend their Catholic faith. In the collective memory of all there has never been a single divorce among the Croatian Catholics of the city. The population of this city is almost 100% Catholic, and they live their faith very seriously.

However, what marks this profoundly religious attitude is that they see marriage as a cross indissolubly united to the Cross of Christ. This leads spouses to face their union without romanticism, false expectations, or illusions. Realistically, they know that in this valley of tears everyone has defects.

During their married life, the spouses find strength by praying together before the crucifix they hold together during the religious wedding ceremony. After kissing the cross, the spouses enthrone it in a place of honor in their homes, showing their profound belief that a family must be born of the cross.

This attitude is consistent with the belief that the cross will give them strength to overcome daily trials if they ground their marriage on it. The spouses are keenly aware that if one abandons the other, they will abandon Christ. Experience teaches that the source of perseverance through which they will gain eternal life can only come from the Cross of Christ rather than any external factor.

The Lively Virtues

We've all heard of the 7 Capital Sins and been told to avoid them. Sometimes called the Deadly Sins, they are listed in "These Men They Call Knights," the handbook presented to every K of C First Degree initiate. Their folly and danger are frequent topics of Sunday readings, like those of August 4th from the Books of Ecclesiastes and Luke, with all of them mentioned by our esteemed Chaplain Msgr. Jim Forsen during a recent homily. But what about the good stuff? What about the qualities that please God? They are what we should focus on and strive to attain. For each and every Capital Sin there is an antithetical Lively or Heavenly Virtue.

After Greek theologian Evagrius of Pontus chronicled 8 offenses and wicked human passions in the 4th century, Pope Gregory I the Great consolidated them into a list of 7 sins in 590 AD, and a series of corresponding virtues was soon recognized. Opposite the sin of Pride or conceited vanity is Humility, where ultimate truth in the love of God is expressed through encouragement of others' success. Obsession with riches through Covetousness, also known as greed or avarice, is countered by Generosity, and shown through liberal acts of unselfish giving done for the common good. Next is the virtue of Chastity, which counters the sin of Lust. Chastity is characteristic of respect, and not a behavior, since it rejects treating others as a means for only physical pleasure.

Anger or wrath is won over by Patience, because forgiveness and tolerance defeat vengeance and its inordinate desire for revenge. Gluttony, an excessive craving for food and drink, is injurious to one's mental and physical health. It is suppressed by the virtue of Abstinence, with self-disciplined fasting inspired by God a key to its success. The sin of Envy, a feeling of sorrow at another person's good, is offset by Kindness and admiration, because the truth is we are all equally God's children. Lastly, Diligence is virtuous because zealous confidence in our faith repels the evil of Sloth. Laziness and lukewarm attitudes toward divine precepts limit the growth of our spiritual lives. As Bishop Fulton Sheen put it, sloth leads to a failure to cultivate new virtue, which ultimately deprives us of a closer relationship with God.
