A Catholic Sense of Hospitality

Hospitality is more than a friendly and generous reception involving the entertaining of guests, visitors, and strangers: it's a Catholic tradition. Christianity's embrace of kindness and generosity toward others began at its origins. In biblical times, hospitality was more than being friendly or polite: it was a duty and an act of mercy. Hospitality was necessary for survival, because traveling in the Holy Land was dangerous. Look no farther than the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) to understand its importance.

The biblical lesson of hospitality goes back to the Book of Genesis and the beginning of salvation history. Hosts had a sacred obligation to provide food and drink, water to wash feet, and a place to rest. Their duties also included protecting a guest from harm. Guests were required to accept what was offered, and refusal on either's part was a serious breach of honor.

When Jesus began his public ministry, he was often on the road, dependent upon the hospitality of strangers for meals and a place to rest. He used those meals as an opportunity to teach, and his language of hospitality described the Kingdom of God. "Practice hospitality ungrudgingly to one another," (1 Peter 4:9) or as Saint Pope John Paul II said: "Welcoming Christ in our needy brothers and sisters is the condition of being able to meet him face to face and perfectly at the end of our earthly journey."

Nowadays, the K of C sponsors hospitality at the Church of the Visitation on the second Sunday of each month, after the 8:00, 9:30 and 11:00 AM masses. Coffee, doughnuts, and camaraderie are shared by the families of Knights **Chip Mallek**, **Jeff Rogers** and **Alex Flores**. They're always looking for helpers, while St. A's and St. J's would no doubt enjoy similar Knightly welcomers, because there's never too much hospitality to go around. 


