### Being a Practical Catholic in a Secular World is No Easy Task

Catholicism is not like a box of chocolates where practical followers pick and choose what they want to believe or obey. Whether it's alternative views on the sanctity of life, or belief that stealing isn't all that bad if taken from somebody with more than us; straying from practicality creates a slippery slope that destroys faith and leads to estrangement from God. Our own Church's abuse scandal shows us the result of deviating from practical obligations. Those involved in the abhorrent behavior often justified in their actions by believing they knew better than the Church. Man's reasoning, when devoid of revelation, makes it easier to stray from a path of righteousness, and especially when another trail seems easier or more convenient to trek.

By definition: "A Practical Catholic accepts the teaching authority of the Catholic Church on matters of faith and morals, aspires to live in accord with the precepts of the Catholic Church, and is in good standing in the Catholic Church." We therefore don't adhere to beliefs of the secular world; rather we follow God's teachings. It was summarized by Jesus in his own words: "I am not of this world." (John 8:23)

The 7 Precepts of our Church are: To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation; To fast and abstain from meat on appointed days; To confess one's sins at least once a year; To receive Holy Eucharist during Easter time; To contribute to the financial support of the Church; To observe Church laws concerning marriage; and To join in the missionary spirit and apostolate of the Church. To these, former K of C Supreme Chaplain (1961-1987) Charles Pasquale Greco added: Follow Christ's example; Respect the Church's teaching authority; Defend Church teachings; and Pray frequently.

For honorable Knights there is no debate: If we are not living these basic precepts, then we are not being Practical Catholics, nor are we living up to our obligations as good Catholic gentlemen. It's a tough thing to do in a secular world where popular opinion often persecutes the righteous. We did not become Knights because it was easy; rather we did so for the betterment of society, in fidelity to God: "In service to One, in service to all."

Christmas Reminder: The Peoples Republic of China flagrantly persecutes Christians, especially Roman Catholics. Please check the labels of your Christmas purchases to ensure they are from places that respect Catholicism. Let us do what is right and not financially support those who maltreat our Church. Vivat Jesus!

Dear Friend, Did you know a mother facing a crisis pregnancy usually chooses adoption, parenting, or abortion within 24-48 hours of finding out she's pregnant. However, only 2% of women in an unplanned pregnancy choose adoption.




