



Honoring the Future While Remembering a Friend



Each young man and woman was presented a certificate of appreciation, while one distinguished member of each graduating class received the inaugural Vincent Migliazzo Service Award, presented by the Knights of Columbus, Council #3744, for exceptional dedication, "In Service to One, in Service to All."

Recipients of this year's Migliazzo award, chosen by their parish's pastors, are: Elizabeth Dennis of St. Anastasia, Jasmine Hernandez of St. Jerome, and Ella Tran of the Church of the Visitation. Congratulations to you all on an outstanding achievement, and just to let you know, your award is named for a pretty special guy.

Sir Knight Vince Migliazzo, our Council's Past Grand Knight, passed away earlier this year, but not before achieving a remarkable legacy. Vince was a native of Los Angeles who graduated from Mt. Carmel High School, Loyola University, and received his Masters degree from USC. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII, and was awarded the Bronze Star and Purple Heart for gallantry on the battlefield. Vince returned home to teach at Mt. Carmel and Morningside high schools before retiring from the Inglewood School District as Assistant Superintendent: Quite a lifetime of service to others.

Vince was the epitome of "In Service to One, in Service to All," but he held a special place in his heart for young adults who devoted time to God and public. For years he led a small team of family and friends who honored graduating altar servers, and although he has passed, his legacy lives on through this very special award. 






It's a Grand Old Flag – Under God!

Respectful and patriotic Americans pledge allegiance to their country's flag which flies over "One nation, under God." The reason the oath contains the phrase is not by happenstance. It's there because the Knights of Columbus initiated a campaign in 1951 to lobby for its public adoption to text originally composed in August 1892. After our Order's Board of Directors amended the pledge's recitation at 4th Degree assembly meetings, congressional representatives were asked to adopt the same language nationwide. They agreed.

As a result, President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed a law officially adding the words "under God" to the pledge on Flag Day, June 14, 1954.
