The Ladies of Columbus share their male counterparts' mission of promoting charity, unity, fraternity, and patriotism, while advancing the general welfare of the Knights of Columbus order. Fr. Emil Kapaun's Lady Knights auxiliary is a self-governing group attached to Council #3744. It is not affiliated with the more structured Columbiettes, founded in 1939 by Monsignor J. Francis McIntyre of New York (later Cardinal McIntyre of Los Angeles), even though the Lady Knights fulfill a similar function. The Columbiettes are devoted to 3 patronesses:

The Blessed Virgin Mary – foundation of all true motherhood; St. Therese, the Little Flower – whose zeal to serve God welcomed any opportunity to make sacrifices; and St. Joan of Arc – who was always ready to give aid unselfishly to those who defended righteous causes. Columbiette chapters are very few, however, with their dues-paying members limited to Knights' wives, mothers, sisters, daughters, and widows.



We thank our own Ladies of Columbus, especially Grand Lady **Joanne Bisho**, **Marlene Migliazzo Kaufman** and **Irene Mussack** to name but a few, for all of the work that they do. Their membership dues is \$20 per-year, and they try to meet once a month (except during COVID) to socialize and plan a variety of charitable activities. Community service with a firm reliance on God brings our Ladies together in the same camaraderie and esprit de corps that unites Knights of Columbus' men. Council #3744 invites good Catholic women to join our Ladies of Columbus auxiliary so they too can reap the enjoyment felt by providing service to others. Pro Life & Decency

The 2021 March For Life

The annual March for Life was held on January 29, 2021, highlighted by events in Washington, DC, including a virtual rally and gala dinner. Activities in other cities including Los Angeles were also limited to virtual events due to COVID-19 protocols. The purpose of the March For Life is to raise awareness about the plight of the unborn, as well as respecting the sanctity of life from conception to natural death. The annual March celebrates life coincides with the anniversary of the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade ruling that legalized abortion in all 50 states. This year's DC "virtual" rally included speeches by pro-life leaders, sharing information about involvement in pro-life activities, and a musical performance by Christian singer-songwriter Matthew West.

A Rose Dinner Gala was held that same evening in Washington, DC, featuring a keynote address by former Heisman Trophy winner and pro-life advocate Tim Tebow, while Supreme Knight Carl Anderson of our own Knights of Columbus was honored by event organizers with the 2021 Pro-Life Legacy Award in recognition of his lifetime of exceptional work advocating for the inherent dignity of the unborn human person. Additionally, the annual 40 Days For Life campaign is being held locally between February 17th and March 28th. The campaign seeks to end abortions at the Planned Parenthood facility in Lawndale through peaceful, First Amendment-protected activities including prayer vigils. 

Founder's Day Is Coming

March 29th is Founder's Day marking the 189th anniversary of when Fr. Michael J. McGivney incorporated the Knights of Columbus. What you may not know is the Knights first met under their name at St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut, on February 6, 1882. About 60 perspective members gathered under the guidance of soon-to-be Supreme Knight James T. Mullen to establish by-laws that included limiting membership to Catholic gentlemen between the ages of 18 to 45 (Glad that's changed!). Fr. McGivney founded the Knights as a lay organization, with a goal of preventing Catholic men from entering secret societies whose membership was antithetical to Church teaching. The Knights also formed to unite men in their Catholic faith, and to provide for the families of deceased members.

Our New Supreme Knight

Habemus Summo Equiti! We have a new Supreme Knight! On February 5, 2021, Patrick E. Kelly of Connecticut was elected to succeed Carl A. Anderson as our order's 14th Supreme Knight. Supreme Knight Kelly assumed his role on March 1st following Supreme Emeritus Anderson's stepping down upon reaching the mandatory retirement age of 70, and after leading the Knights of Columbus for over 20 years.

Supreme Knight Kelly is an attorney who grew up in Michigan, and spent 24 years in the U.S. Navy as both a JAG and intelligence officer. He was Deputy Supreme Knight for the past four years, and has headed the Knights' "Leave No Neighbor Behind" campaign during the COVID pandemic. He is a third generation Knight, with his grandfather having joined in 1915 before leaving for service in World War I. His father was also an active member of a local council up until the time of his death, while our new Supreme Knight joined the order as a student while at Marquette University in 1983.

In his first remarks as Supreme-elect, Patrick Kelly spoke of his leadership goals including strengthening family life and promoting unity in a time of division. "Inspiring the next generation of Knights is personal for me," he remarked, adding: "Our mission is to strengthen Catholic men." The newest Supreme Knight also highlighted his belief in the importance of members supporting Council activities, as well as asking all Knights to be witnesses to our founder Blessed Rev. Michael J. McGivney's mission by ensuring we remain a brotherhood of faith, "as a Church, as a country, as families and as men."
