How the Fall of 1881 Profoundly Changed Our Church

Several members of Council #3744 attended Mass at the Church of the Visitation on October 11th honoring Blessed Father Michael J. McGivney and the Knights of Columbus. It was Columbus Day and fittingly celebrated by our Past Worthy Chaplain **Msgr. Charles Hill**. Msgr. Hill reminded attendees that it was also the feast day of Saint Pope John XXIII, who like Father McGivney forever changed the Roman Catholic Church – especially participation by its laity. How appropriate that this year's celebration of Columbus Day, which became a national holiday in 1934 because of lobbying by Father McGivney's Knights, fell on the feast day of a man often called "the Happy Pope."

John XXIII was responsible for convening Vatican II, held between 1962 and 1965. Formally designated the Second Ecumenical Council of the Vatican, it introduced revolutionary changes to our Church. Vatican II's profound reforms included allowing Mass to be said in the vernacular (local languages like English, as opposed to only in Latin), having the priest face the congregation rather than the tabernacle, and giving a larger role in Church activities to lay people – just like Father McGivney intended when he founded the Knights of Columbus eighty years earlier.

It's amazing how the lives of a future saintly pope and blessed parish priest intersected the same year. Pope John XXIII was born Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli in the Northern Italian village of Sotto il Monte on November 25, 1881. His birth took place the month after New Haven, Connecticut's 29-year-old assistant pastor at St. Mary's Church convened a gathering of parish men on October 2, 1881. Father McGivney asked them to join him in establishing a lay organization to prevent Catholic men from entering secret societies antithetical to Church teaching. They were also assigned a mission to assist families of deceased members of the Order – something they did the following year. The fall of 1881 thus gifted the world with both a future Italian-born revolutionary pontiff, and a dynamic Catholic fraternal organization named for another famous son of Italy who earned his fame sailing the seas in 1492.

Two years after that we relocated to our current home at 8049 West Manchester Avenue in Playa Del Rey, with the first Council meeting held there on September 29, 1959. How many wonderful events and dinners have taken place since then? It's why we are proud to proclaim – Happy Anniversary to Us!



Thanks to the tremendous efforts of **Paul Callinan**, we were able to sell tickets at the Westchester Farmers' Market. Because of his efforts, the help of other Knights and especially the Boy Scouts Troop 915, we sold \$394 of tickets. The car show, organized by **Tino Carbajal**, greatly assisted the effort by drawing people by the K of C tents. An excellent community effort all around!


