Knights of Columbus History - A Timeline by Papacy (Part One)

This month we look at the history of the Knights of Columbus, and place it in perspective of who was Pope when milestone events occurred. Part two will appear in the January 2022 bulletin.

Blessed Pius IX (1846-78) – Michael John McGivney was born in Waterbury, Connecticut, on August 12, 1852, and ordained a priest by the Roman Catholic Church in Baltimore on December 22, 1877. His ordination took place shortly after the First Vatican Council (Vatican I) was held between 1869 and 1870, to address earthly issues including the rising influence of rationalism, liberalism, and materialism in society.

Leo XIII (1878-1903) – Father McGivney proposed establishing a lay Catholic fraternal order on October 2, 1881. It was founded on principles of Charity and Unity, named the Knights of Columbus, and elected its first officers on February 6, 1882. The Order was legally incorporated on March 29, 1882. The Knights added the principle of Fraternity in 1885. Father McGivney died in Thomaston, Connecticut, at age 38, on August 14, 1890. The Vatican acknowledged the Knights for the first time in 1895. Its apostolic delegate to the U.S. extolled the “merits of this splendid Catholic organization” by giving the Knights an apostolic blessing. The principle of Patriotism was added, and the first 4th Degree exemplification took place in New York City on February 22, 1900.

St. Pius X (1903-14) By 1910, Knights councils spread throughout the U.S., Canada, Mexico, the Philippines, Cuba, and Panama, while membership grew rapidly.

Benedict XV (1914-22) During World War I (1914-1918), the Order provided rest and recreational facilities, and social services to Allied servicemen of all faiths in Europe. Their efforts earned high praise from Pope Benedict, while the Knights’ membership grew by nearly 400,000 during his papacy. Benedict XV personally invited the Knights to build several recreational centers for Roman youth. In August 1920, he gave a papal audience to 235 Knights who made a pilgrimage to Rome.

Pius XI (1922-39) Father Hawe 4th Degree Assembly #45 was founded in Santa Monica on January 2, 1924. The Knights engaged in post-war charitable work, offering education and employment assistance to returning servicemen. The Order stood at the forefront of combating bigotry by working to overturn laws targeting Catholics, like a 1923 Oregon statute prohibiting children under 16 from attending private schools – a law later declared unconstitutional by the U.S. Supreme Court in 1925.

Pro Life & Family Values

Pushback Against Planned Parenthood Fundraiser at LMU

An on-campus fundraiser by LMU Women in Politics on November 5th raised \$4,100 for Planned Parenthood, the nation's leading abortion provider. Announcement of the event led to backlash from pro-life elements nationwide because it was held on the grounds of Jesuit-sponsored Loyola Marymount University in Westchester. The pro-life group RenewLMU circulated a petition asking LMU to cancel the fundraiser, but the university declined despite its obvious conflict with Catholic Church teachings.

Archbishop José Gomez said he was “deeply disappointed” by LMU’s decision. Only after intense criticism did the university issue a statement: “LMU regrets the concerns this situation has caused our community members and Catholic partners... Moving forward, LMU is reexamining and revising its policies and practices regarding student-organized activities to ensure stronger alignment with our mission.” In response, LMU Women in Politics’ supporters condemned pro-life critics for wanting to stifle free speech on campus. Nevertheless, it’s difficult to imagine those same people defending LMU had it allowed a Ku Klux Klan gathering at the school despite the hate group’s antagonism towards core Catholic Church values.

When LMU student Megan Glaudini heard about the Planned Parenthood event she felt “convicted” to do something about it. Disgusted and embarrassed by LMU’s apathy, she went out and made a difference by resurrecting a longtime inactive pro-life campus group called VITA, Latin for “Life.” Glaudini and VITA’s first action was to stage a candlelit Rosary and rally in front of LMU to protest the pro-abortion fundraiser taking place inside its Roski Dining Hall. Courageous people of conscience Megan should be applauded for taking a stand in defense of innocent life at a time when the pro-life movement is too often persecuted by opponents in the media and society in general.

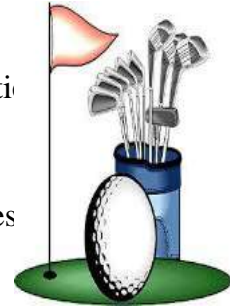

Pope Francis Venerates First Class McGivney Relic

Pope Francis received Supreme Knight Patrick E. Kelly, chief executive officer of the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization, for a private audience on October 25th. Kelly, accompanied by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore, and former Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, presented the pontiff with a first-class relic of Blessed Michael McGivney. Pope Francis held a golden reliquary containing the relic and venerated it, while the Supreme Knight expressed his deep appreciation to the Holy Father for the beatification of our Knights of Columbus founder one year ago.

Pope Francis earlier praised the Knights' charitable work in February 2020, including the order's annual donation to the Pope's personal charities through the Vicarius Christi Fund. The Knights donated more than \$57 million to the fund between 1981 and 2017. "Since its foundation, the Knights of Columbus has demonstrated its unswerving devotion to the Successor of Peter," Francis stated. "The establishment of the Vicarius Christi Fund is a testimony to this devotion, as well as to the desire of the Knights to share in the pope's solicitude for all the Churches and in his universal mission of charity. In our world, marked by divisions and inequalities, the generous commitment of your order to serve all in need offers, especially to young people, an important inspiration to overcome a globalization of indifference and build together a more just and inclusive society."

Knights of Columbus History - A Timeline by Papacy (*Part One*) continued

(Pius XI) The Knights fought against critics who spread a “bogus oath” defaming their Catholic Order. It claimed the Knights pledged to wage war against Protestants, and “crush their infants’ heads against walls.” New York Governor and Brother Knight Al Smith faced heavy opposition from the KKK while on the presidential campaign trail in 1928. He lost the election, but ironically 6 of 7 states he won were in the deep South. The Knights led efforts to make Columbus Day a national holiday in 1934. In 1936, Cardinal Eugenio Pacelli, Vatican Secretary of State, visited the Knights’ headquarters in New Haven. Three years later, he became Pope Pius XII.
