Remembering the True Martin Luther King Jr.

We recently celebrated the life of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. with a national holiday. It was first observed on January 20, 1986, and has since become an annual event recognizing the importance of equality and civil rights. The special day honors Dr. King's efforts to eliminate bigotry and erase lines that divide our society. Yet along the way, since his death at the hands of an assassin on April 4, 1968, the most important element of King's being has been brushed aside by many for reasons that would certainly alarm him.

Dr. King was first and foremost a man of God, a Reverend and minister of the Holy Bible. The First Amendment to the United States Constitution begins with the words: "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof." Unfortunately, too many people misinterpret the phrase to mean a prohibition on anything religious, whether sight or sound, in our secular society. Sadly and ironically many of those who shout "separation of church and state" employ a double-edged sword of rewriting history to paint religion in a shameful light, while "prohibiting the free exercise thereof" as remedies to ensure compliance.

The crusade to separate Dr. King and the civil rights movement from their religious origins falsely interprets history. It grossly misunderstands the man who first and foremost was the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. His legacy is not one of leading a secular social justice movement devoid of religious inspiration. That Godless drive, which often invokes his name while embracing the tenets of Marxism, too often turns a blind eye to vandalism of houses of worship. It is indifferent to, or outright supports the toppling of monuments dedicated to St. Father Junípero Serra, Christopher Columbus, and even the Blessed Virgin Mary and Jesus Christ her son. That would be abhorrent to the towering figure of religiosity who championed rights for us all during the 1960s, while giving his life for what he believed in the process.

Many have tried to eliminate Columbus Day as a national holiday, or replace it with Indigenous People's Day in an attempt to rewrite history and promote their own political agendas. Others claim they should be combined to recognize divergent points of view. How about then we combine Dr. King's yearly holiday with Religious Freedom Day? It is a right guaranteed by our Constitution, and certainly needed in an era like now where intolerance towards all things religion is growing at an alarming rate. What would Dr. King think of the idea? It's hard to imagine the Baptist minister would have any problem sharing his day with one that supports respect for the Deity he spent a lifetime praising. For those who object on anti-religious or secular grounds, they fail to recognize the real Martin Luther King Jr. and what he truly represented.




