An ever-so-brief glimpse of something odd caught my eye. There, hidden amongst the green, red, orange and yellow was a patch of charcoal gray. Something deep inside the shrub's intertwining network of creepers didn't look quite right.

Rather than sever the vine as planned, then take a look at it later, something caused me to pause and give the unusual little dark blotch a closer examination. I'm certainly glad that I did because secured to the base of the strong support branch was a golf ball size little nest. Protruding from its top were two tiny figures with needlelike beaks, ready for their morning meal. It was a pair of baby humming birds who unbeknownst to me had hatched and were living just a few feet from where I pass by every day. All I could think of was to thank God for allowing me to recognize them as being something special rather than ignoring those two little miracles. I just can't imagine the awful feeling had I taken their life line away.



There are a million little miracles surrounding us. They're hidden all around; often in plain sight, waiting to be found. Whether in bushes or trees, on sidewalks, or obscured behind walls, God's little wonders are there for discovery – if only we take time to recognize them. Some are fauna, others flora; some earthly and others heavenly. There are those that are intangible, like the miracles inside us all. Hopefully we catch God's miracles, large and small, before we make that final cut without appreciating their beauty. 
A Big Game Day to Remember!



Fraternal Insurance Agent Report

March arrives and Lent begins on the very next day, March 2. We all know that Lent is the time of preparation for Easter. It begins on Ash Wednesday and ends with Holy Thursday. In order to prepare to celebrate the Lord's resurrection we are to exercise selfcontrol and self-denial by fasting. We are encouraged to encounter Christ in the reading of Scripture and we are to serve others by the giving of alms.

When I was a kid, the "go to" self-denial was giving up chocolate...made those chocolate Easter bunnies most tasty! I think a lot of us are creatures of habit when it comes to self-denial. We continue on the same path, "giving up" the same things each year. Although self-denial is important as a practice, I've gotten a little older and a bit more introspective. As we prepare spiritually for this new liturgical season of Lent, don't forget the temporal. Tempus fugit, memento mori! I am honored to carry on our blessed founder's vision of protecting Catholic families.
