Remembering K of C Council #2991

Contrary to what many of us believed, Westchester's first Knights of Columbus council wasn't Father Emil Kapaun #3744. Even though we celebrate our 69th anniversary this year after being granted a charter at the Westchester Women's Club on November 17, 1953, there was another local council before us. As brought to our attention by Brother **John Skidmore**, Loyola University Council #2991 came into existence on the LMU campus on June 21, 1946. Although now defunct, it was active for around 50 years before disbanding. Its last tax filing as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization was years later in 2009, when it claimed \$0 in assets.

The issue of #2991 came up when Brother **Mike Sanchez**, a visiting Knight who expressed interest in possibly joining #3744, attended our June council meeting and told us he first became a Knight through LMU's council in 1981. Brother Skidmore, who works at LMU, mentioned there is a Knights of Columbus marker from a building erected for Council #2991 in 1954. The marker is now embedded in the sidewalk across the street from the campus chapel. Do you have any information you'd like to share about Council #2991? Rancho San Antonio Ticket Sales

Council 3744 has kicked off our fundraising efforts for Rancho San Antonio, "Boys Home of the West". Rancho San Antonio exists to help rehabilitate abused or neglected adolescent boys and keep them from ending up as just another negative statistic. Los Angeles Knights of Columbus councils have supported this facility for many years, primarily through sales of fundraising raffle tickets.
