# Why Was the Knights of Columbus Started?

So, why exactly was the Knights of Columbus started? Look no further than the words of our founder, Father Michael J. McGivney, who in April 1882, wrote:

"We have formed an organization under the name of the Knights of Columbus. Our primary objective is to prevent our people from entering *Secret Societies*, by offering the same, if not better, advantages to our members. Secondly, to unite the men of our Faith throughout the Diocese of Hartford, that we may thereby gain strength to *aid* each other in time of sickness; to *provide* for decent burial, and to render pecuniary assistance to the families of deceased members. The aid to which the family of a deceased member shall be entitled is regulated by the grade to which such member belongs in the Endowment fund."

To Fr. McGivney's first point, the late 19th century was a time of great conflict between the Catholic Church and Protestant-dominated fraternal organizations. Many *Secret Societies* served as "old boys' networks," used to find employment for members, while excluding "undesirables" (Catholic immigrants) from the job market. Most Protestant dominated fraternities, like the Freemasons, Odd Fellows, and Knights of Pythias, demanded members swear oaths of secrecy, even superseding what could be said inside the confessional. By 1917, a Catholic man who joined a Masonic Lodge faced automatic excommunication from the Church of Rome.

To Fr. McGivney's second point, the Knights provided Catholic men with their own fraternal group, but one that was faithful to Church principles. To his third, the Knights initiated an insurance plan to assist survivors of families whose breadwinners passed away. Thankfully, Freemasons and most other Protestant *Secret Societies* today do not zealously discriminate as they did in the past. Nevertheless, the Order founded by Fr. McGivney 140 years ago allows Catholic gentleman to join together in communion and good standing with others who share their faith.



# St Margaret Center Update

Council 3744 has supported St. Margret Center for years. In addition to the volunteer hours performed, the council also contributed \$600 annually to purchase gas for the center's van.

During the last Columbian year, members of this council volunteered 1,700 hours. We gathered 400,000 pounds of food donations from 10 local markets making pick-ups once, twice or three times a week depending on the market. Total weight collected was approximately 200 tons. Besides picking up food we also help sort, box, shelf and distribute the food.

This achievement was accomplished by the following Knights: **Chip Mallek**, **Tom Mallen**, **Mark Brosmer**, **Ken Lockwood**, **Alan Engler** and **Mike Engler** PGK.

We would especially like to acknowledge the long time work of **Arnold Tena**, who has dedicated many years of service to St. Margaret's Center including coordinating the Knights' efforts for a number of years and **Richard Wagner** for his many years of service especially in the Food Bank runs. I will especially miss our discussions on the way to and from the Food bank.

However, we could not have accomplished this great effort without the assistance of our families and friends.
