What made him special was not just because he had a wonderful way with words; an eloquence, what the Irish call *Bronntanas Gab*, or "the Gift of Gab." Rather, he was a consummate professional. As offered by another Hall of Fame broadcaster, Los Angeles Kings' legend **Bob Miller**, the thing that most defined Scully as the best in his business was that he was always prepared.
