### **Council Support of Alexandria House**

This past Christmas season, Council 3744's annual support of Alexandria House, a transitional home for women and children, assisted deserving mother **Jacquan** and her three children, ages 8, 6, and 2-years-old. She and her children escaped an abusive situation only to be forced to live on the streets. By the grace of God, she found Alexandra House and of course was not turned away. Jacquan receives vocational rehabilitation, is learning how to run a business and will soon be transitioning to the "new" Alexandra House Apartments (directly behind the two original houses). Alexandra House was able to purchase the building through several very generous donors, and grants from Immaculate Heart Community.

Alexandra House has a new Executive Director, **Marissa Espinoza**. **Michele Richards** is the Director of Development, and **Sister Judy** has now transitioned to donor development. As you can imagine, along with expansion and growth of operations comes a need for even more resources to accomplish their wonderful mission. I am personally very happy that our Council is so generous and able to support Alexandria House. Through the many Brother Knights who were so generous, and our Knights of Columbus Council, we were able to give Alexandra House \$1,145 for Jacquan, to help her transfer to independent living and fill her new (small) one bedroom apartment with furniture and essential needs.


