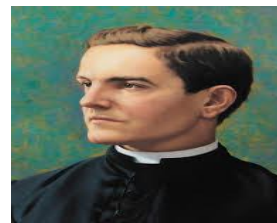

What Does It Mean To Be A Practical Catholic

Lent is a time to adjust our lives by giving up material things as a form of self-sacrifice while we pause to renew our relationship with God. Consequently, it is a good time to ask: What does it mean to be a good Catholic in the modern world? Becoming a Knight of Columbus requires candidates to be practicing Catholics, male, and at least 18-years-old. Another condition is that they be “practical Catholics.” But what exactly does that mean? According to the Knights’ Supreme Council: “A practical Catholic accepts the teaching authority of the Catholic Church on matters of faith and morals, aspires to live in accord with the precepts of the Catholic Church, and is in good standing in the Catholic Church.”

The precepts of our Roman Catholic faith are: To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation; To fast and abstain from meat on appointed days; To confess one’s sins at least once a year; To receive Holy Eucharist during Easter time; To contribute to the support of the Church; To observe the laws of the Church concerning marriage; and To join in the missionary spirit and apostolate of the Church. We also adhere to Christ’s two great commandments: “Love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind,” and “Love your neighbor as yourself.” (Matthew 22:37-39)

In the lead up to Easter it is therefore important to support God’s Church by attending weekly Mass and engaging in dietary abstinence. It is also a time to update our Reconciliation with God, to embrace him by receiving the Eucharist, and to give alms to both the Church and those most in need, all created by God. Most importantly, however, we love. That is what being a practical Catholic is all about.
